## STUDY NAME: PREPARATION OF A TEMPORARY SLIDES

## Materials required

- Specimen
- \*\*\*

Petridishes

• Mounting fluid (glycerine)

- Razor blades
- Water

• Camel hair brushes

- Slides and cover slips
- Stain (safranin) solution
- A piece of fine cloth and tissue paper

### **Steps**

A. Sectioning B. Staining and C. Mounting

# A. Sectioning:

- ♦ Keep the specimen in a petridish containing water
- ♦ Hold the specimen vertically with thumb and indicating finger of left hand and the razor blade horizontally with right hand
- ♦ Cut the section repeatedly
- Keep the sections in the petridish containing water
- Select the thin and uniform sections with the help of camel hair brush.

## **B.** Staining

- ◆ Transfer the thin and uniform section from water to another petridish containing 1% safranin solution and allow it for few (2-3) minutes.
- ♦ Wash it with water to remove excess stain

## C. Mounting

- ◆ Take a clean and dry slide and a cover slip
- ◆ Put some mounting fluid at the center or 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of total length away from the left corner of the slide
- ♦ Keep the stained section on the mounting fluid
- ♦ Put a cover slip on the section
